# The Motorways Traffic (M621 Motorway) Regulations 2023

Made	2023
Laid before Parliament	2023
Coming into force	2023

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 17(2) and 17(3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a).

Representative organisations have been consulted in accordance with section 134(2) of that Act.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Motorways Traffic (M621) Regulations 2023 and shall come into force on 2023.

## Interpretation

- **2.** In these Regulations the "specified length of carriageway" means those parts of the westbound carriageway of the M621 Motorway in the City of Leeds which lies between—
  - (a) a point 145 metres east of the centreline of the Belle Isle Bridge and a point directly on the centreline of the Dewsbury Road Bridge;
  - (b) a point 86 metres east of the centreline of the Holbeck Moor Underpass and a point 32 metres west of the centreline of the Tilbury Road Footbridge; and
  - (c) a point 16 metres east of the centre line of the Lowfield's Road Subway and a point 108 metres west of the centreline of the Lowfield's Railway Overbridge.

## Regulation 12 of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982 not to apply

**3.** Regulation 12 of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(**b**) (restriction on use of the right hand or offside lane) shall not apply to any vehicle using the specified length of carriageway.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations disapply regulation 12 of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982 (which prohibits certain vehicles from using the right hand or offside lane of a motorway carriageway with 3 or more lanes) in relation to the length of the westbound carriageway of the M621 Motorway defined in regulation 2.

These Regulations also revoke the Motorways Traffic M621 (Motorways) Regulations 1999 in their entirety.
