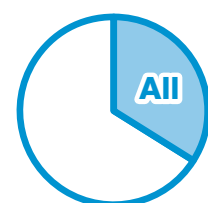


Across England:

Three quarters of imports and exports are moved by road



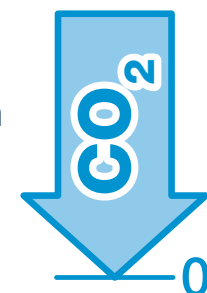
Investment in the **strategic road network** directly supports **64,000 jobs**
