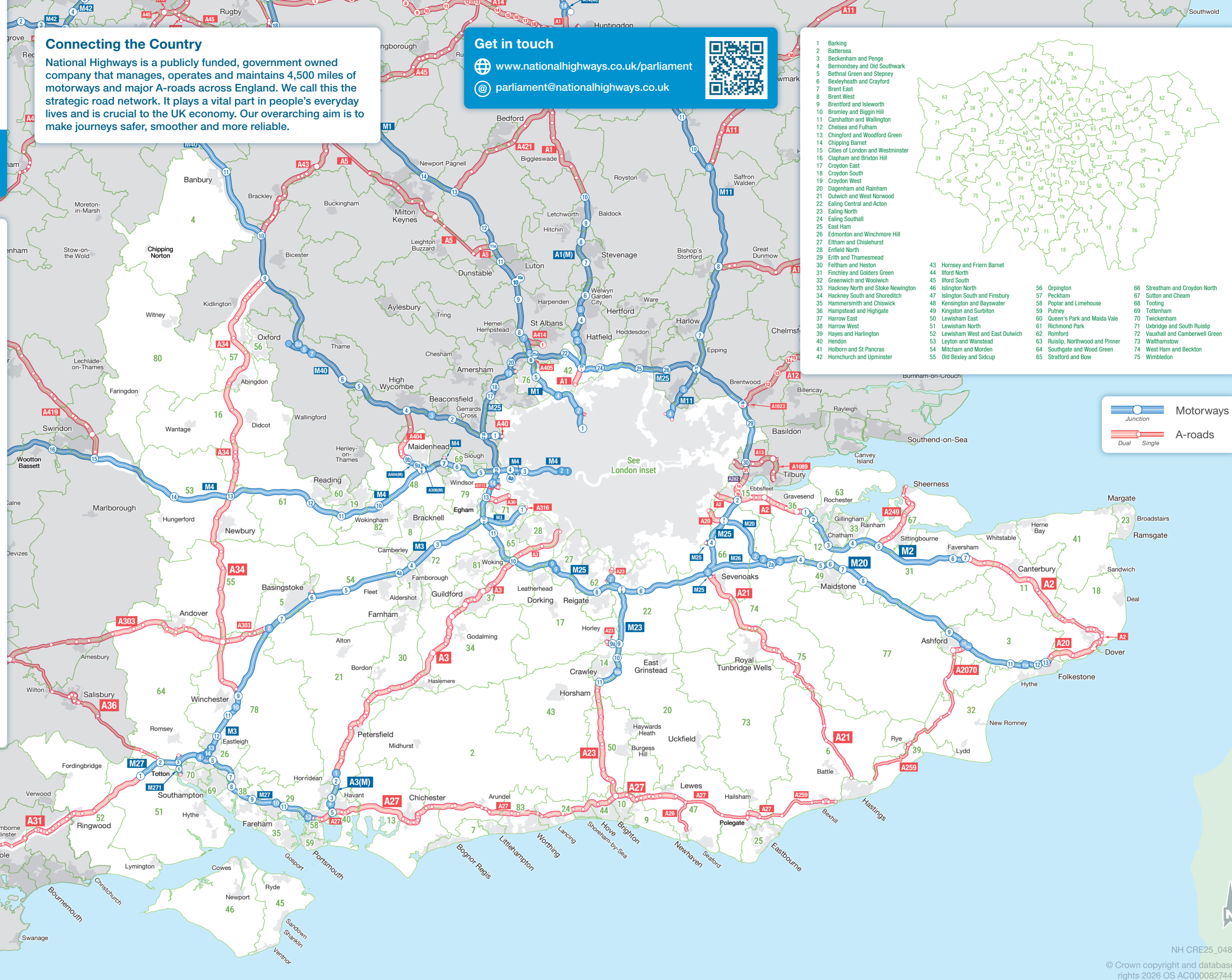

We operate **500 miles of motorways and major A-roads**

Across England: Our network has an asset value of over **£156 billion**

95 billion miles are travelled on our roads every year

34% of all traffic and **68%** of freight journeys

Three quarters of imports and exports are moved by road
